

HACIENDA BAY – Repurposing Plan

Sanford Golf Design is pleased to announce the resurrection of Hacienda Bay Golf Resort on the north coast of Egypt. Construction of the course was stopped in January 2011 when the revolution movement removed then President Mubarak from office. After sitting idle for almost 3 years, the owner, Palm Hills Development has reengaged Sanford Golf Design to provide repurposing design services. The overall course area, turf area and length of course will be reduced to lower water consumption and maintenance costs.

This masterfully planned desert style golf course takes full advantage of the sites natural features with an innovative environmental approach that is highlighted by a ‘super dune’ rising 12 meter above sea level. This future site for the relocated clubhouse offers magnificent views of the Mediterranean Sea and pristine lagoons.

The repurposed golf course will play approximately 6,654 yards/par 70, while the original design was 7,241 yards/par 72. Construction will resume on the course this winter.
